**KALABURAGI, KARNATAKA**

**5th, July 2019**

**NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR PROTECTION OF CHILD RIGHTS**

**NEW DELHI**

*Working Report*

## Introduction

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights conducted its Divisional level Bench at Kalaburagi District in Karnataka. The Bench was organised on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019, which consisted of Dr. R.G. Anand and Smt. Pragna Parande, Honorable Members of National Commission for the Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), Dr. Anthony Sebastian, Chairperson State Commission for Protection of Child Rights, Karnataka (KSCPCR); Sh. R. Venkatesh Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate, Kalaburagi, Sri Iada Martin Marbaniang, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kalaburagi. The purpose of the Bench was to reach out to more and more children across the country. Such Camps and Benches will be taking up grievances/complaints/representations pertaining to violation of child rights. One of the objectives was also to strengthen 115 Aspirational Districts identified by NITI Aayog. In this regard, a District level Bench of NCPCR was scheduled for 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at Kalaburagi Division. Nearby Districts- Ballari, Koppal, Raichur, Yadgir, Bidar were also invited for the Bench.



### Role of NCPCR during the whole process:

#### Pre Bench Activities:

Following steps were taken by the Commission before NCPCR's Bench at Kalaburagi, Karnataka.

- Dissemination of information regarding conducting the Bench with District & State Administration: After deciding upon the schedule of NCPCR's Bench/camps, a letter was sent to the District Collector of the concerned District with copy of procedure.
- Video Conference & Follow-ups with the District and State Administration:

After sending the letter, the second step was to hold video conference with the concerned nodal officer of the District.

- Information to NGOs & Follow ups:

NCPCR after taking out list of NGOs from Niti Aayog Darpan portal, send invitations to the NGOs for their contribution in spreading awareness and mobilizing the complainant at the venue. Also information regarding the Bench was given over phone.

### **Preparation for the Event:**

- A team comprised of Technical Expert, Consultants & Data entry operator from NCPCR- Ms. Shaista K Shah, Senior Technical Expert Child Health, Sh. Abhikarsh Tyagi, Consultant, Legal cell, Sh. Shakti Singh, Consultant, POCSO Division and Ms. Kanika Bhradwaj, DEO reached Kalaburagi District on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019

### **NGO MEETING**

A meeting with NGOs was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019 at Vidhan Soudha, DC's meeting room, Kalaburagi. The NCPCR team along with the Assistant Deputy Commissioner, Kalaburagi chaired the consultation meet. During the meeting, the NCPCR team informed the NGO's about the objective and purpose of constituting a National bench to look into the matters of violations and deprivation of child rights in the Kalaburagi Division. The team also informed the respective NGO's about the roles and responsibilities of the Commission and work done by the commission all over the years in protecting and preserving the rights of children. Out of 86 NGOs of Kalaburagi registered at Niti Aayog portal, total 14 representatives of NGOs/ Child line from all the five adjoining districts of Kalaburagi and representatives of ICDS and State Commission for Protection of Child Rights, Karnataka (KSCPCR) were present for the meeting. The team of the Commission informed the NGO's about the objective of bench and asked them to spread awareness of the NCPCR's Bench and asked them to mobilize people who wants to give their complaints and grievances and also to represent their complaints.

### **KEY HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE NGO-MEETING-**

- Around 14 NGO's participated in the meeting held with NGOs held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019.
- Representatives of Child line and 5 other NGOs have agreed to volunteer in running the Divisional level Bench smoothly and efficiently.
- Representations of the NGO's were aware of the issues of child rights.
- NGO's highlighted the issue of school dropout, POCSO and non-implementation of RTE in specific areas.

- One of the representatives of NGO shared the concept of Children's club in rural areas.

### **Meeting with District Officials**

A meeting with the Nodal officers of six Districts – Kalaburagi, Ballari, Koppal, Raichur, Yadgir, Bidar and concerned officials of the Departments of Women and Child Development, Education, Social Welfare, Labour, Health, Child Welfare Committee, Juvenile Justice Board was held on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at Vidhansoudha. All the nodal officers were present for the meeting. Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC) of Bidar District submitted list of 118 cases with remarks of the concerned officials. Meeting was chaired by Dr. R.G. Anand, Member, and NCPCR. All the concerned nodal officials were briefed about the procedure of the Bench and their roles. District Collector, Kalaburagi informed all the officials to spread maximum awareness of the Bench and generate matters of child rights violation.



### ON THE DAY OF THE SITTING OF THE BENCH -An overview -

On 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2019, the Bench was held at Mahasoudha, DC's court at Kalaburagi, Karnataka.

Following were the main features of the Bench-

- **Help/Facilitation Desk-** Help/Facilitation Desk was set up outside of main hall. As Kannada is main language of Karnataka, so to get the complaint translated in English, 10 Professors of College as volunteers for translation (kannada to English) were appointed by the District Administration.
- **Registration Desk-** Each and every complaint was registered and token with a number was given to the complainant. 10 volunteers from Child line, NGOs and some professors of the college were deputed for registration of complaints/grievances.
- **Remarks/Comments of the concerned Departments-** After registration of complaints, concerned authorities were asked to give their comments/remarks on the complaints.

### Hearing by the Bench

The Commission conducted its Divisional level Bench at Kalaburagi District in Karnataka. The Bench was organised on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019. The Bench consisted of Dr. R.G. Anand and Smt. Pragna Parande, Honorable Members of National Commission for the

(KSCPCR); Sh. R.Venkatesh Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate, Kalaburagi, Sri Iada Martin Marbaniang, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kalaburagi. CEO of all the six Districts, ADC, Kalaburagi were also present there. NCPCR's Bench was started with inaugural. After welcome song by students of Appa Public School, welcome address was delivered by the District Collector, Kalaburagi. Inaugural address was given by Honorable Members, NCPCR Dr. R.G. Anand and Smt Pragna Parande. After inaugural address, members, NCPCR interacted with media and briefed about procedure of NCPCR's Bench for redressal of matters pertaining to violation of child rights.

**Cases of Child Sexual Abuse in child friendly manner-**The cases which were received by the Bench related to child sexual abuse were heard separately by Member, NCPCR in camera in a separate room. 5 cases were registered under POCSO and immediate instructions were given to the Police Officials and Child Welfare Committee.

### **Highlights of the Divisional level Bench held at Kalaburagi-**

**In total the bench received 902 complaints- 150 Complaints heard by the bench. Below is the information on the total number of cases received during the sitting of the bench.**

## **COMPLAINT ANALYSIS-As per NITI AAYOG INDICATORS**

The National bench of NCPCR is being conducted in those districts which are declared 'aspirational' by NITI Aayog. The NITI Aayog analyzed these districts based on 49 indicators segregated in five sectors- Health, Education, Agriculture & Water resources, Financial Inclusion and Basic Infrastructure. Since NCPCR has a mandate to take complaints in the matters related to child rights violations. Therefore, the Commission has placed its focus on three key sectors- Education, Health & Nutrition focusing on the facilities provided to children.

1. **Education-** Infrastructure, harassment in school and admission related.
2. **Health-** Inadequate facilities in Aanganwadi Centres in Yadgir District and issues related to children with disability.

In Education, the Commission received complaints related to financial assistance and scholarships, admission/enrollment in schools under norms of RTE Act, 2009, infrastructure and lack of basic amenities, admission of children with disability. The bench/camp has received complaints majorly of financial assistance and admission in schools.

In health major complaints were received regarding financial help for treatment and regarding disability certificates. Complaints were also received regarding infrastructure of Anganwadi centers. Number of children with disability and cerebral palsy appeared in the Bench.

### OBSERVATION OF THE OFFICIAL

National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) focused on certain points of roles and responsibility of the officials of the respective districts which they need to fulfill before and during the sitting of the bench.

- To bring the total number of complaints pending before the district related to child rights violations.
- The presence of district officials during the sitting of the Bench along with requisite staff for assistance in addressing the complaints.

## **Good practices**

- 28 cases reported to Kalaburgi Education Department were resolved by DDPI.
- 68 cases reported to DC Bidar and all the issues were taken up as well as resolved.
- Children from Child Rights Gram Sabha of 55 Gram Panchayats of Yadgir District submitted grid of 657 cases pertaining to schools and Aanganwadi centres.
- Order was passed by the Bench to DM to submit compliance report within 3 months.

## **Observation**

- The Nodal Officers from all the districts of Kalaburgi Division actively participated and provided their valuable support to the Bench.
- The Commission received complaints from NGO's, Childline, individual complainants etc. The representation of the NGO's during the proceeding was commendable. The NGO's volunteered for the Bench and also brought the complaints from other Districts before the bench and certain NGO's submitted their complaints to their district officials.
- The Childline was active during the bench and provided all the necessary assistance required for the bench/camp. Childline volunteers also helped the Bench in translating the matter from Kannada to English.

## **Conclusion**

The National Bench at Kalaburagi Division, Karnataka was conducted successfully. NCPCR registered 902 cases pertaining to violation and deprivation of child rights and passed ordered orders in 150 cases. Commission also received cases from District Collector Bidar and from other District Officials of Bellari and Raichur. The Commission received full support of the District Administration of Kalaburgi and participation from the NGO's from different districts and other stakeholders. The volunteers from the schools, childline, NGOs and district administration helped in the proceedings of the bench/camp smoothly.



